

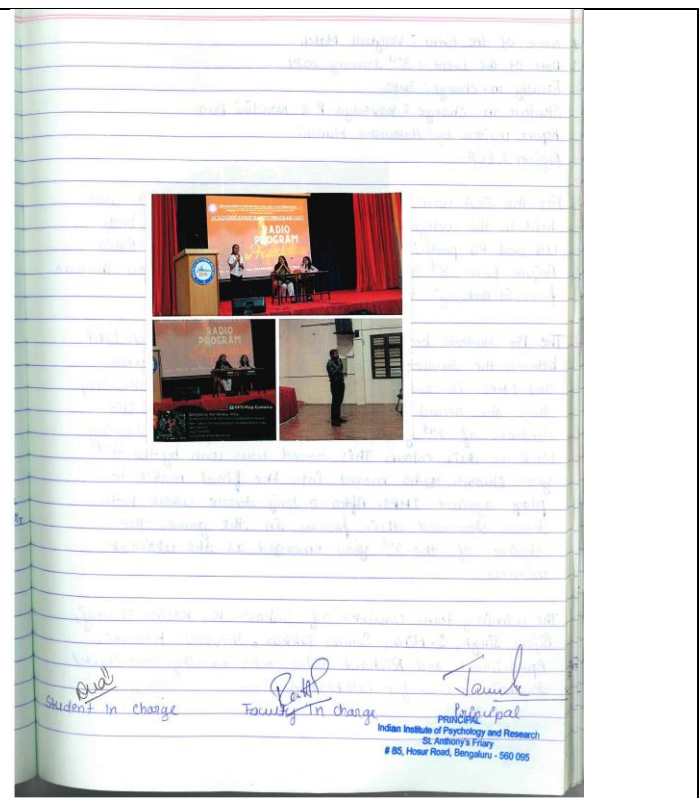
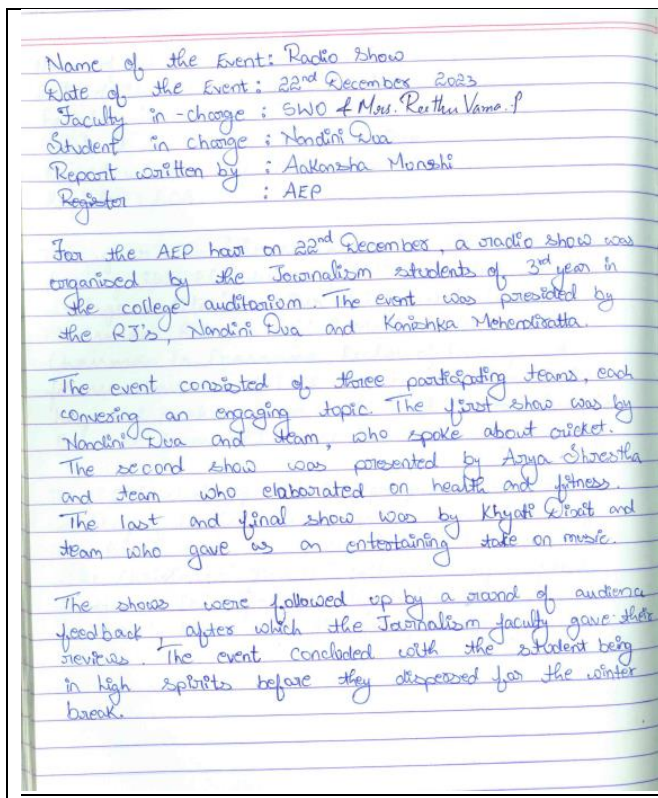


Capacity building and Skill Enhancement

Book Review

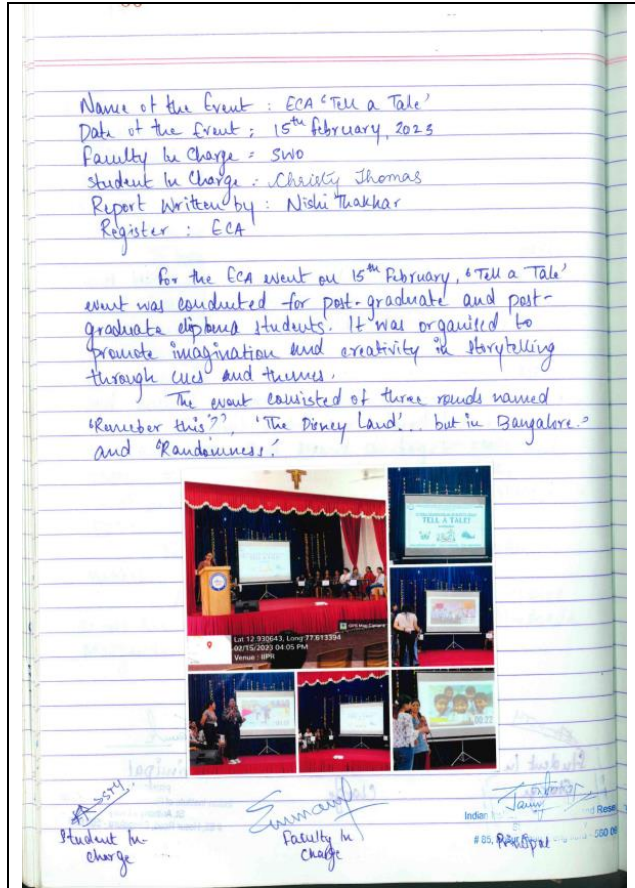
Student of Undergraduate Programmes reviewed and analysed books and presented it to the audience. The session was moderated by a faculty and facilitated shaping language and analytical skills.

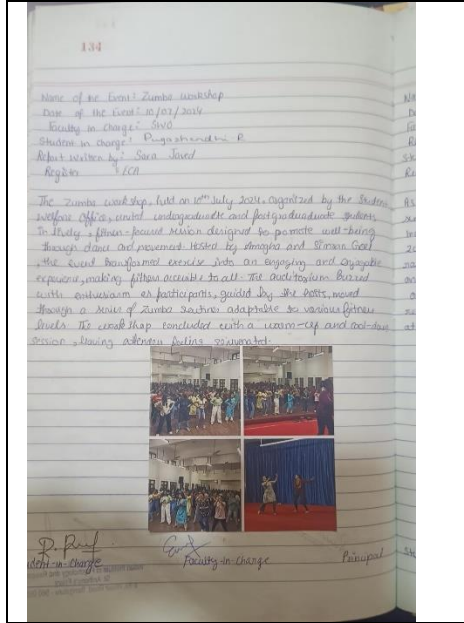

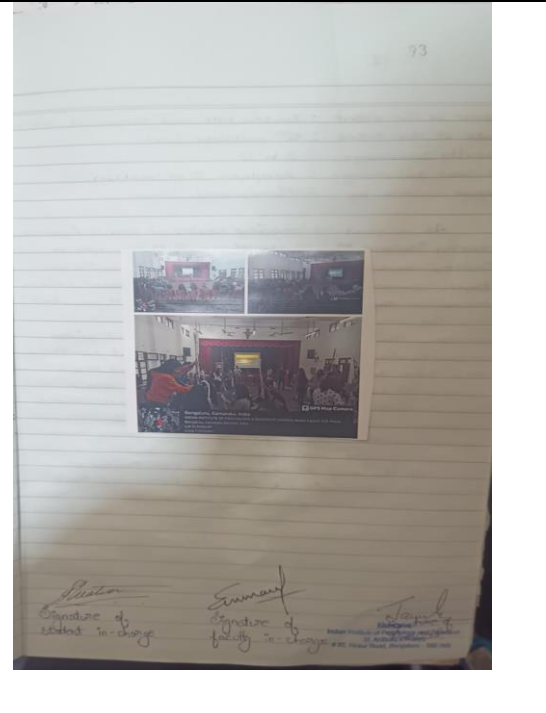
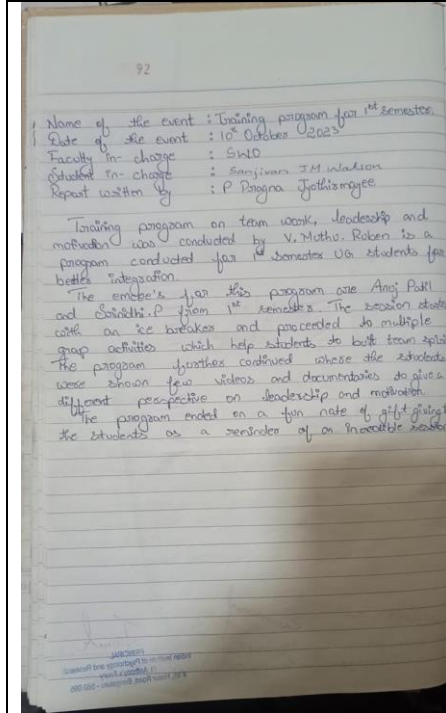

For the AEP hour of 29th November, Mrs. Techa Paul, the founder and CEO of Giftalexia was invited to deliver a talk on the topic of "Awareness on learning disability" in the college auditorium. The emcee of the day was Amogha Agarwal from MPC.

The session began with her introducing the organisation, Giftalexia. It is an award-winning startup recognized by the government of India which aims towards helping children which have dyslexia in terms of their compensating advantages while acknowledging the challenges that they face. She elaborated how children with dyslexia are often able to make connections across complex issues because they are out of the box thinkers. She also spoke about how a large percentage of children who have dyslexia drop out of school due to lack of proper support and emphasised on the need for educational institutions to be more inclusive towards them.

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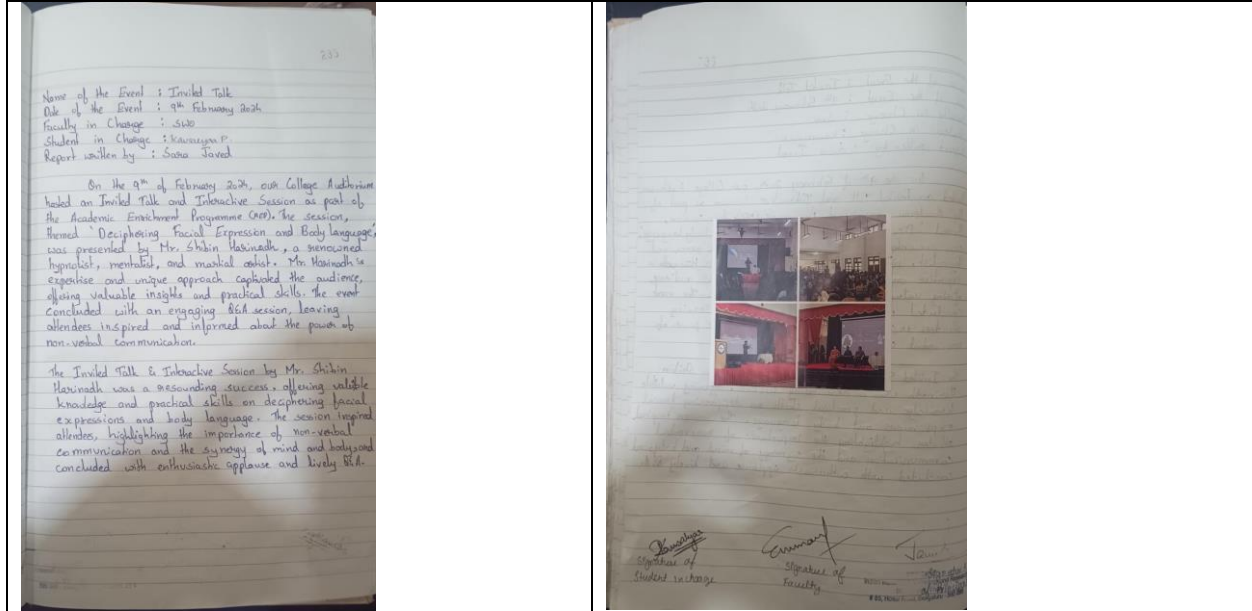
