



The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at the Indian Institute of Psychology and Research (IIPR) has been newly established in response to the formal decision to seek accreditation from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). The current IQAC comprises an IQAC Coordinator and members, from various departments and fields of expertise. Together, these member coordinators have been actively engaging in regular meetings during the year periodically, focusing on planning and executing various initiatives aimed at enhancing the quality of education within the college.

These initiatives include continuous training and mentoring programs designed to help teachers improve their classroom delivery techniques and effectively evaluate student performance. Additionally, they plan co-teaching activities that promote collaboration among faculty, and they take steps to address any grievances that may arise within the academic community. At the beginning of each semester and the academic year, the IQAC team undertakes a careful review of course plans, offering constructive feedback and suggestions for enhancing teaching methodologies and evaluation strategies. They also conduct periodic assessments of the courses completed to identify any challenges faced by educators, subsequently recommending remedial measures to overcome these obstacles.

Furthermore, the IQAC guides the student welfare office and student council advising them on the types of activities that should be organized and suggesting suitable speakers or experts to invite for various academic enrichment programs. In collaboration with SWO, IQAC organizes various in-house and off-campus curricular and co-curricular activities such as invited talks, guest lectures, panel discussions, documentaries, alumni connect, career guidance, training programs, commemoration of national and international days, various arts, sports, and literary competitions etc. During the year IQAC also focussed on staff welfare and skill upgradation through training programs, orientations, and Faculty Development Program.

Through these efforts, the IQAC aims to foster a culture of continuous improvement and excellence in education at IIPR.
