CHRIST (Deemed to be University) was born out of the educational vision of St Kuriakose Elias Chavara, an educationalist and social reformer of the nineteenth century in South India. He founded the first Catholic indigenous congregation, Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI), in 1831 which administers CHRIST (Deemed to be University).

Established in 1969 as Christ College, it undertook path-breaking initiatives in Indian higher education with the introduction of innovative and modern curricula, insistence on academic discipline, imparting of Holistic Education and adoption of global higher education practices with the support of creative and dedicated staff. The University Grants Commission (UGC) of India conferred Autonomy to Christ College in 2004 and identified it as an Institution with Potential for Excellence in 2006. In 2008 under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Ministry of Human Resource Development of the Government of India, declared the institution a Deemed to be University, in the name and style of CHRIST (Deemed to be University). One of the first institutions in India to be accredited in 1998 by the NAAC, and subsequently in 2004 and 2016, CHRIST (Deemed to be University) has the top grade 'A' in the 4-point scale.

The multi-disciplinary University which focuses on teaching research and service offers Bachelors to Doctoral programmes in humanities, social sciences, science, commerce, management, engineering, education, and law to over 18000 students. The campus is a living example for the harmonious multiculturalism with students from all the states of India and around 60 different countries. CHRIST (Deemed to be University) publishes six peer-reviewed research journals and has published more than 300 books in Kannada and English. A promoter of sports, music and literary activities, it is a nurturing ground for creative excellence.

Department of Languages

The Department of Languages which exists since the inception of the institution, currently offers Hindi, Kannada, Sanskrit, Tamil and French as second language in all the UG programmes. In addition, French is offered in BHM, BCA, BBA F & IB, MBA (T&T) and MA in Int. Studies, and German in BCA and MBA Programmes as elective papers. The Department offers ten courses – Spoken Kannada, Vedic Maths, Wikipedia Education Programme, French, German, Spanish, Russian, Japanese, Korean and Chinese as open electives to all disciplines across the University and since 2016-17, two levels (A1 & A2) of French and German, with international certification. To promote digital learning, the Department has initiated the Wikipedia Education Program in the Indian languages, in association with the Centre for Internet and Society A2K since 2013. True to its vision 'to create an understanding and awareness of the Indian heritage of Language, Literature and Culture' the Department inculcates literary and cultural sensibilities in the students through Bhasha Parishat, the Centre for Culture. The Kannada Sangha, renowned all over the state has more than 240 publications to its credit.

To commemorate the Golden Jubilee of the Institution as well as celebrate the 150th birth centenary of Mahatma Gandhi, the Department has ventured to organize a two day seminar on the following theme.

Relevance of Gandhism in Contemporary Indian Literature

Gandhism is a body of ideas that describes the inspiration, vision and the life work of Mohandas Gandhi. It is particularly associated with his contributions to the idea of nonviolent resistance, sometimes also called civil resistance. The two pillars of Gandhism are truth and non-violence. As a guide to action, Gandhian philosophy is a double-edged weapon. Its objective is to transform the individual and society simultaneously in accordance with the principles of truth and nonviolence. Gandhiji not only gave India its freedom but also gave the world a new thought on nonviolence and sustainable living. His teachings and experiments are more valid today than ever before, especially when the world is trying to find solutions to greed, corruption, violence and a materialistic lifestyle which are putting a very heavy burden on the world's resources.

Original research papers are invited in any of the four Indian languages - Hindi, Kannada, Sanskrit and Tamil; or English, based on any literary form, film or culture studies on the following sub themes but not necessarily restricted to them.
